

Browsing and Searching for eUnits at Onyxon.ca

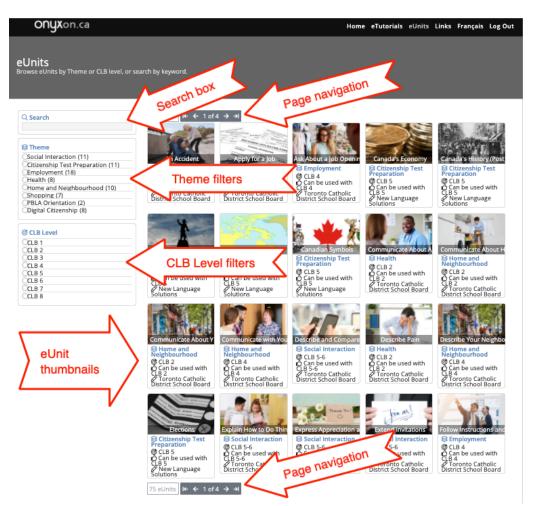
Teachers can use the eUnit Browser to browse, preview and select eUnits. Selected eUnits can be used to build custom courses.

- 1. Log in to the onyxon.ca portal.
- 2. Click the large "Browse eUnits" button or the "eUnits" menu link at the top of the page.



The eUnits page appears. It shows thumbnails of all eUnits arranged by title alphabetically.

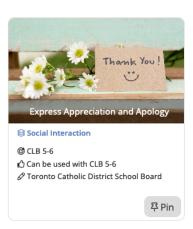
TheceUnits page includes a Search box to search by keyword and filters to sort eUnits by theme and CLB level. eUnits can be filtered by either theme or CLB level or both theme and CLB filters can be used simultaneously to narrow down a search.



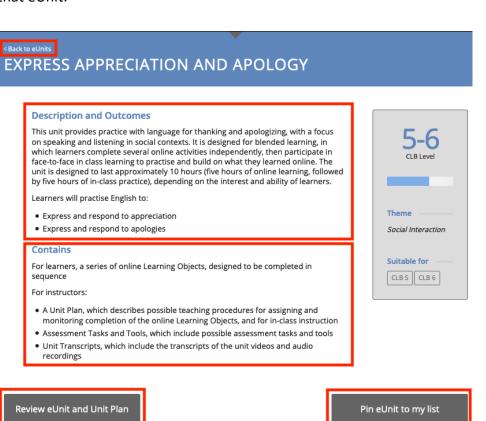
After starting a search, click the Reset Search button above the Search box to reset the filters.



All eUnits appear as thumbnails that include an image with the eUnit name, the theme, the target CLB level(s) and the contributor. There is also a Pin button that can be used to add an eUnit to a course. The Pin feature is available to teachers who have or are approved to have a course on Onyx.



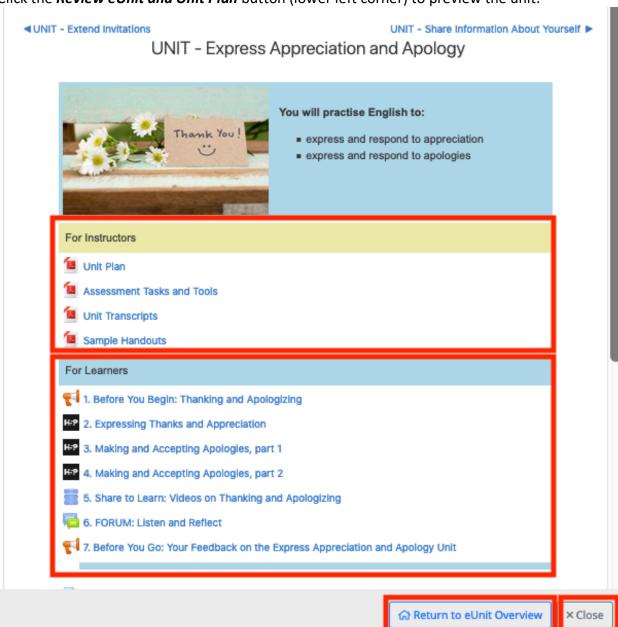
4. Clicking on the eUnit thumbnail image opens a panel with detailed information about that eUnit.





The eUnit panel displays details about the eUnit's language focus in the **Description and Outcomes** section. There is also a section describing the **Contents** of the eUnit. At the bottom of the panel are two buttons. The **Review eUnit and Unit Plan** button opens the eUnit in Moodle, so its entire contents can be previewed. The **Pin eUnit to my list** button (under development) is used to add the eUnit to a course. (Use the **Pin** button in the eUnit thumbnail as an alternative to the **Pin eUnit to my list** button.) The **Back to eUnits** link at the top left corner closes the eUnit panel and return to the eUnits page.

Click the Review eUnit and Unit Plan button (lower left corner) to preview the unit.





All of the contents can be previewed. This includes the resources in the section **For Instructors**, such as the Unit Plan, and the learning activities in the **For Learners** section, such as the H5P learning objects. After exploring an activity or resource, click the **Return to eUnit Overview** button in the lower right corner to get back to the preview page. When you want to stop previewing the contents of an eUnit, click the **Close** button, also in the lower right corner.

- 6. Click the Close button (lower right corner) to exit the eUnit preview page.
- 7. Click the **Back to eUnits** link (top left corner) to close the eUnit panel page.
