

## Flashcards

### Overview

Pre-made *Flashcards* can be found in some units. These activities are identified by a “hamburger” icon (three stacked horizontal lines) on the course page.



Using *Flashcards* is a quick way to review course content. In units with *Flashcards*, you need to try at least one *Flashcard* to earn an *Activity Completion* check mark.

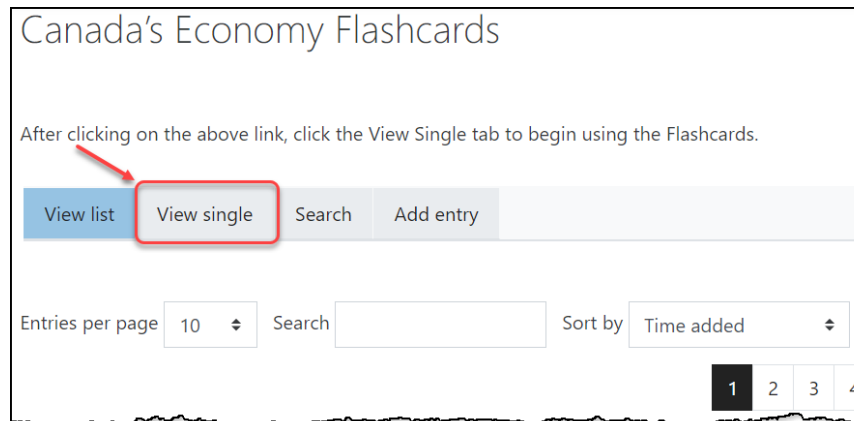
You can change the order of the cards when you repeat the activity.

### Flashcards View

1. Click a *Flashcard* activity, e.g. *Canada’s Economy Flashcards*.

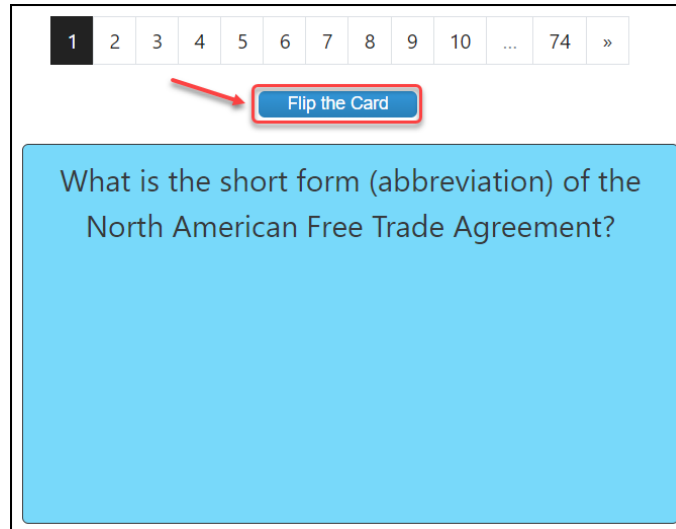


2. Click the *View single* tab.



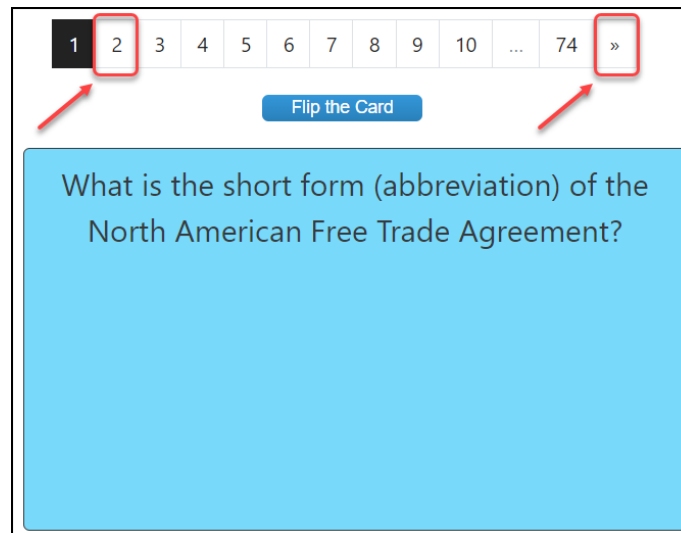
Read the question and think of an answer.

3. Click the *Flip the Card* button to see the answer.



The answer appears.

4. Click on the next number, e.g. #2, or click the double chevron to move to the next card.



It is a good idea to do all of the cards, and even to repeat the activity. You can give yourself a challenge and rearrange the order of cards.

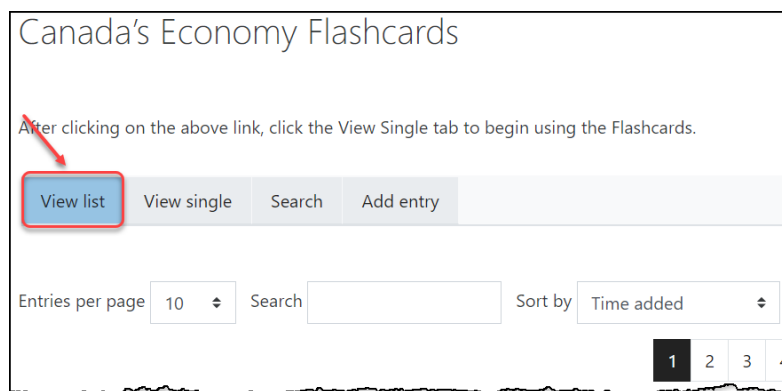
## Rearrange the Order of Flashcards

There are several fields which can be used to sort the order of the *Flashcards*. Here is one example.

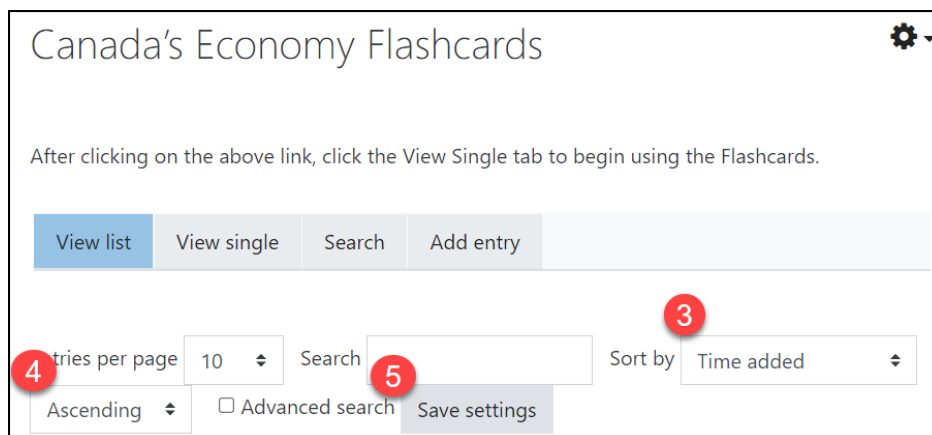
1. Click on a *Flashcard* activity, e.g. *Canada's Economy Flashcards*.



2. Click the *View list* tab.



3. Click on *Sort by* and choose *answer*.
4. Change the order from *Ascending* to *Descending* order.
5. Click the *Save settings* button.



Now when you click on the *View single tab*, you will see that the order has changed.
