

## Quiz

### Overview

Quiz activities are often used for review and end-of-unit assessments. A Quiz may include different question types, such as multiple-choice, drag and drop, short answer, true-false, and others. In the example, we will see a Quiz with multiple-choice questions. Quiz results are recorded and displayed on a summary screen.

Review Quizzes often allow you to repeat the Quiz to help you with your learning. Quizzes used for testing usually only allow one attempt. Both types of Quizzes may be timed.


### Taking a Quiz

1. On the course page, click a Quiz activity link.



The Quiz activity appears.

2. If the Quiz is an assessment task, it might be timed. The information about the Quiz and its time limit will appear on the opening page.

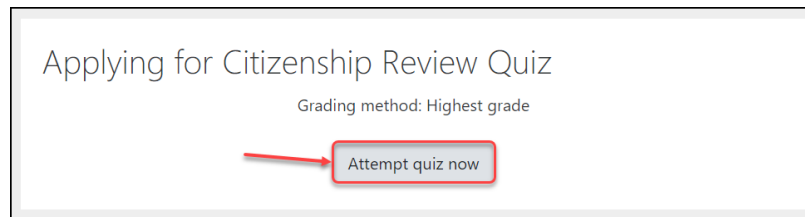

**Attempt quiz now**

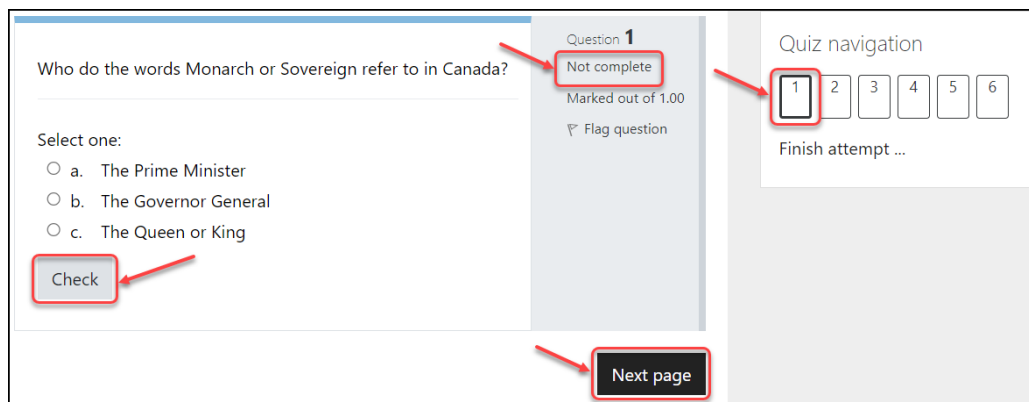
Note that if the *Quiz* is timed, the timer will start as soon as you click the *Attempt quiz now* button, and you will not be able to answer any questions after the time is up.

3. If the *Quiz* is a practice activity it will not be timed. You will see an opening page similar to the one below.



4. Click the *Attempt quiz now* button when you are ready to start the *Quiz*.

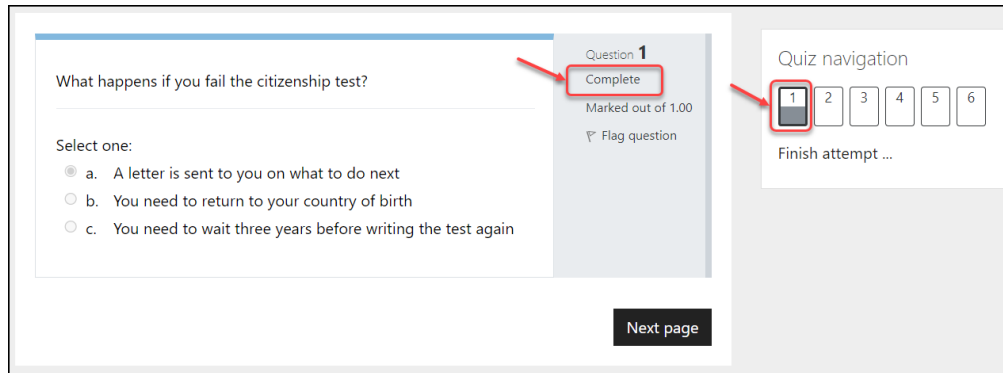
The first question appears.



Note that the *Quiz Navigation* section indicates that the first question is being viewed, and the question is marked as *Not complete*.

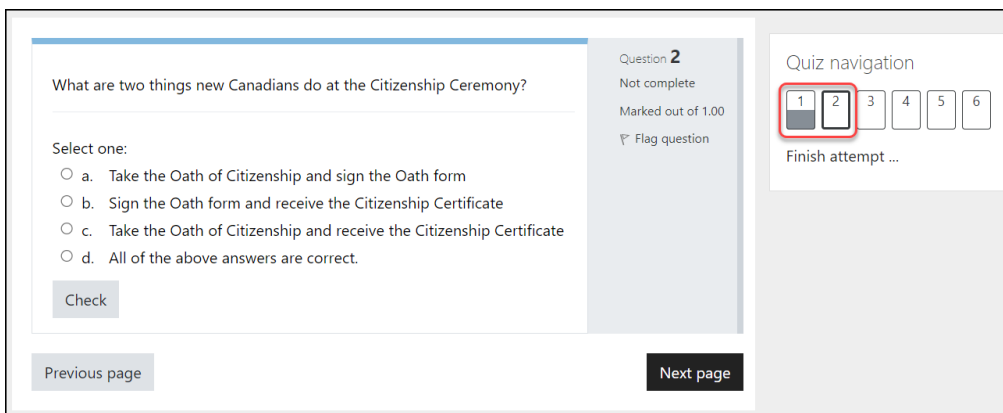
5. Read the question and the choices provided.
6. Click on the answer.
7. Click on the *Check* button.

Note that the question is now marked as *Complete*, and first card on the *Quiz Navigation Block* turns half-gray.



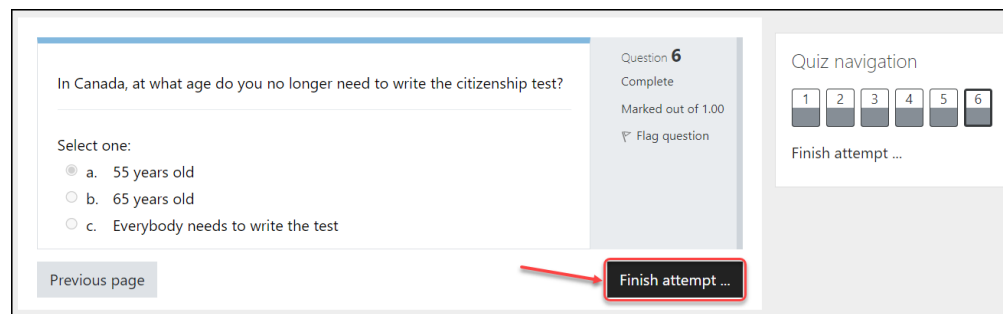
8. Click on the *Next Page* button.

The next question appears. Note that the *Quiz Navigation* section now indicates that the first question has been answered and the second question is being viewed.

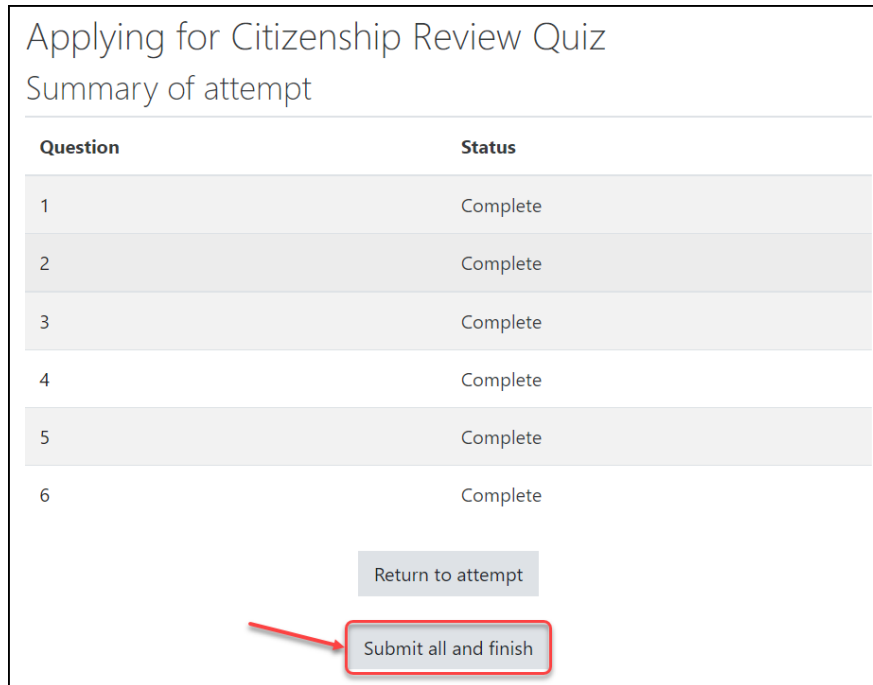


9. Continue answering the questions.

10. Click on *Finish attempt...* when you have answered all questions.

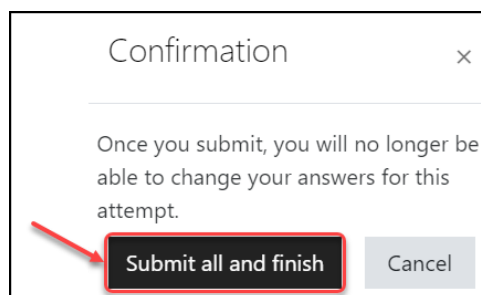


11. The *Summary of attempt* page appears, which shows the status of each question. If all questions are marked as complete, click on the *Submit all and finish* button. If any question is marked as *Incomplete*, click on the *Return to attempt* button to go back and complete the answer.



After clicking on the *Submit all and finish* button, an additional confirmation pop-up appears.

12. Click on the *Submit all and finish...* button.
