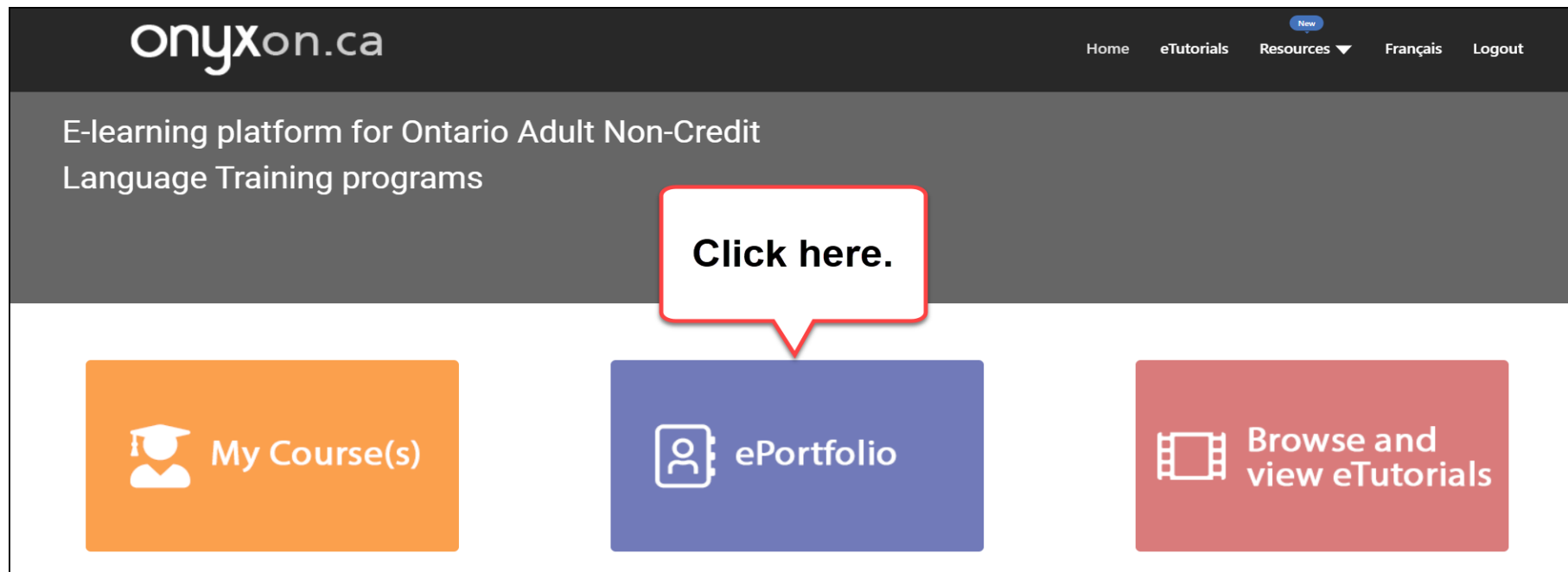


How to Download Files from your ePortfolio

2. Look at your artifact cards.



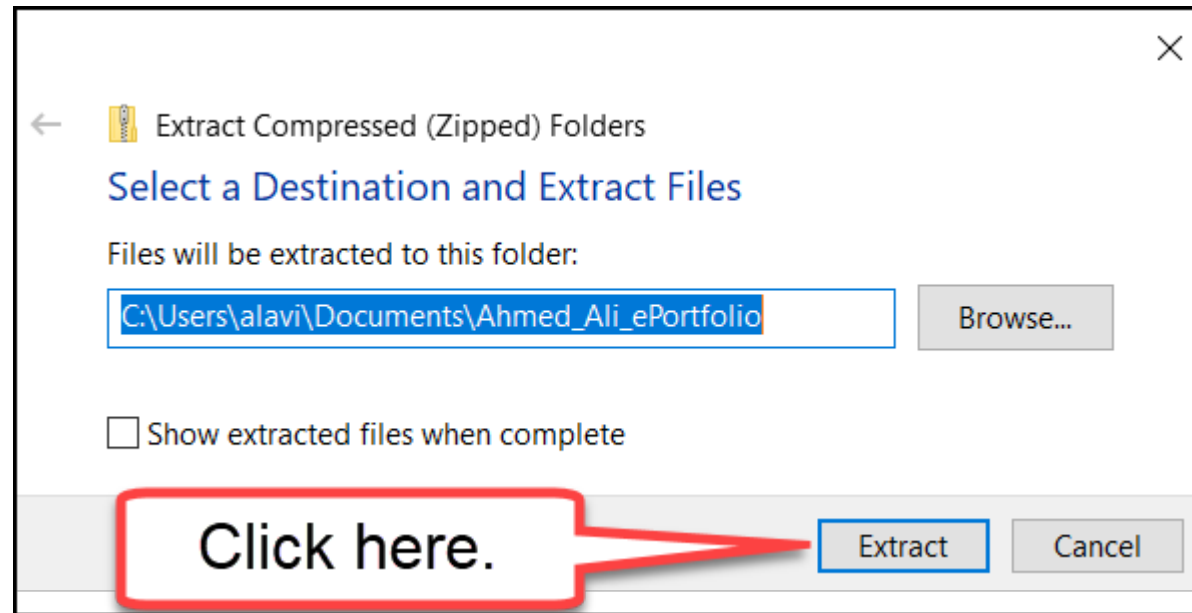
8. Right click on the folder.
