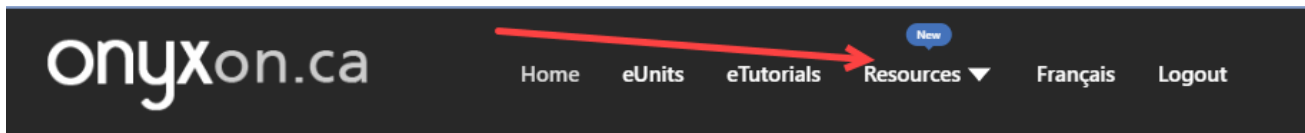


Navigating the Onyx Resources Tab (Instructors)

Instructors have easy access to Stage I and Stage II resources to use with learners, as well as resources to assist them with teaching with Onyx. These are available after logging in to Onyx.

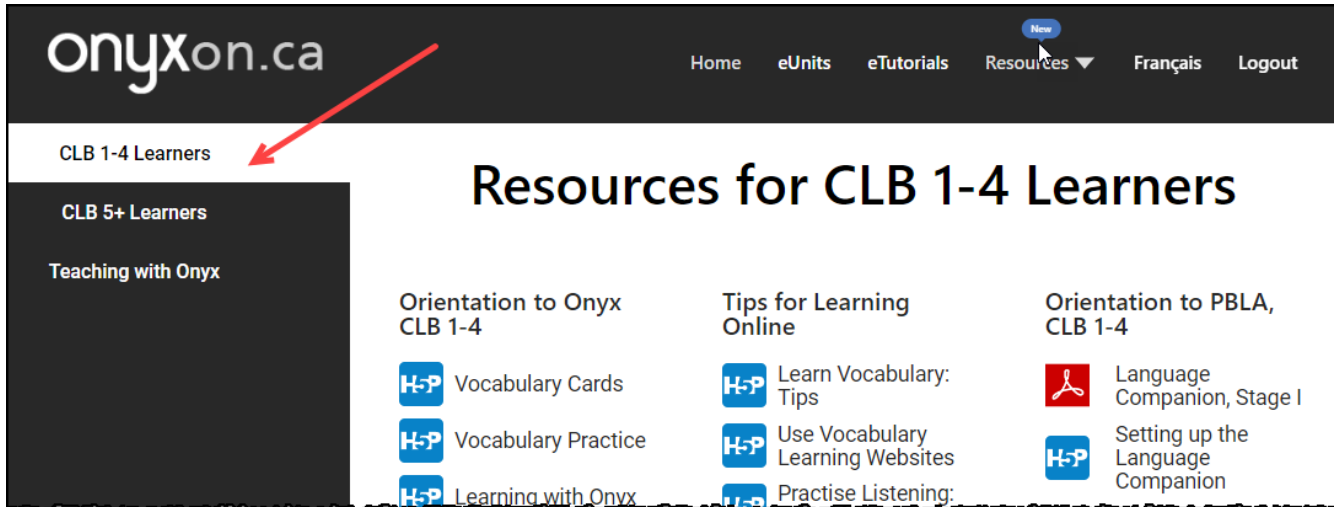
Resources to Help Learners

1. Hover over the **Resources** tab on the banner.



A page of resources opens, with a list of links in a panel on the left.

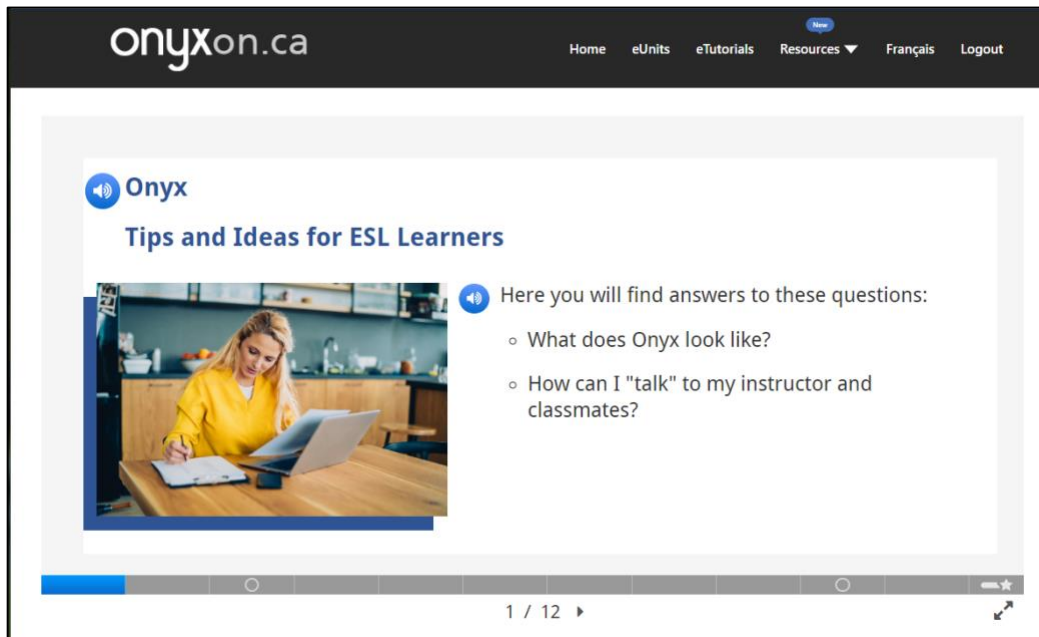
2. If necessary, choose the appropriate level on the left.



Learner resources include Orientation to Onyx (by CLB range), Tips for Learning Online, and Orientation to PBLA (by CLB range).

3. Click on your choice of file.

When a choice is clicked, a file or activity will open that is geared toward learners. In this example, a CLB 1-4 H5P activity opens for Stage I learners.



4. Hover over **Resources** to select a new activity or file, or click the **Home** tab in the banner to exit the activity or file.

Note that the **Onyx Code of Conduct** is available below the resource choices on the **Resources** page.

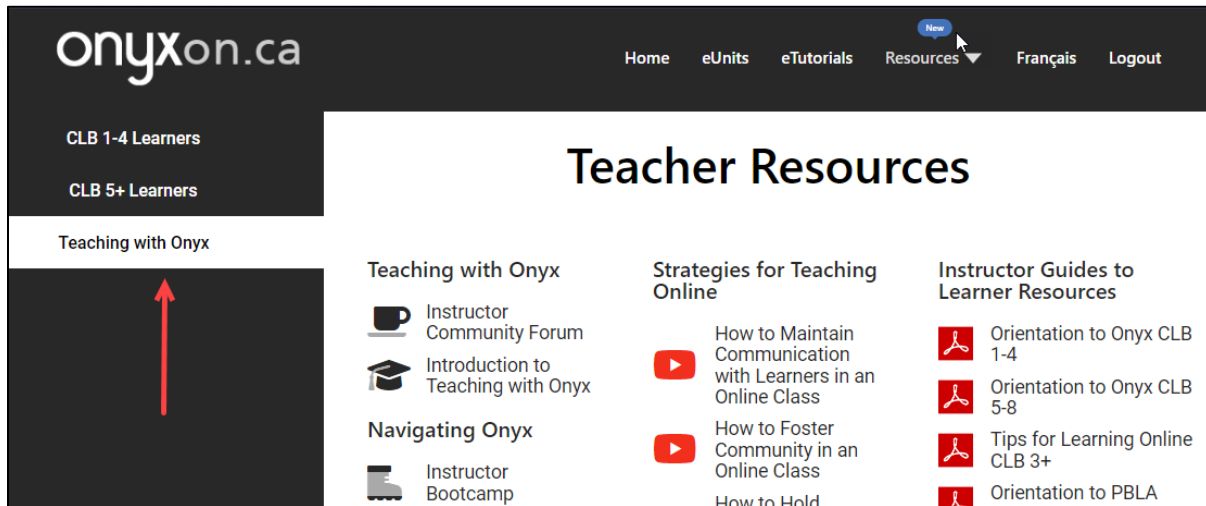
Resources for Teaching with Onyx

1. Hover over the **Resources** tab on the banner.

2. Click on the **Teaching with Onyx** link.

Instructor resources include Teaching with Onyx, Navigating Onyx, Strategies for Teaching Online, Instructor Guides to Learner Resources, and Other Resources.



When a choice is clicked, the selected file, video, forum or course is accessed.

3. Click on your choice of resource.

In this example, a video on How to Conduct Assessment Online was chosen. The resource appears in the current screen. Press the play button to watch and listen.



4. Hover over **Resources** to make a new selection, or use your back arrow or the **Home** tab in the banner to exit the resource.
